Risk Of Recurrence Or Spread It is useful to know



- Lobular Breast Cancer can spread in those with primary and secondary breast cancer.
- Up to 30% of early stage primary patients will experience spread to their organs which can be a number of years after their initial diagnosis.
- Make sure you are aware of the signs and symptoms. Lobular Breast Cancer can spread to different places than other breast cancers, and with different symptoms.

It is OK to act

- Do not ignore any new symptoms that persist for longer than 3 weeks.
- Seek immediate help from your medical team as early intervention is crucial.

It is OK to ask

- Could this symptom be cancer, if so what tests and scans can I have for this symptom?
- Can I have a record of decisions made by health professionals about my care?
- Is there psychological support for me in relation to recurrence and spread?
- If something is detected, what is my treatment plan?
