# What is Lobular Breast Cancer?

Lobular Breast Cancer makes up **15% of all diagnosed breast cancers**. It is the 6th most common cancer in women in the UK.

**22 people in the UK are diagnosed with Lobular every day.** That's equivalent to two football teams.

**Lobular rarely forms a lump, making it hard to see on scans.** As a result, it is often diagnosed at a late stage, requiring more extensive treatment, or even being first diagnosed as secondary disease.

It is an **under-studied and misunderstood disease** that needs better research and treatments.

Despite the evidence, **Lobular is not recognised as a distinct disease** in treatment guidelines across the UK.
